Consent and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk & Indemnity Agreement for Minor

The undersigned parents and/or legal guardians (hereafter referred to in the singular) of _____ (Hereinafter referred to as the "child", "student" or "sailor"), request that the above-named child is allowed to participate in the activities (hereinafter referred to as the "activities") of Coconut Grove Sailing Club (hereinafter referred to as "CGSC").

This Agreement shall remain in effect until CGSC receives written notice of the cancellation of the consent or until the end of child's participation with CGSC, whichever occurs first. In consideration of my child's participation in the CGSC and receipt of coaching and instruction, I acknowledge the following:

AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE: I am familiar with the activities my child will be undertaking as a member of CGSC, and I understand the Coaches of CGSC are available to discuss the activities if I should wish further information. I also understand that I am solely responsible for the arrival and departure of my child and rigging and de-rigging of his/her boat or sailboard at the beginning and end of each CGSC practice. I agree that CGSC and its Coaches will have no responsibility for the supervision of my child at times other than during scheduled CGSC activities. I will inform my child that he/she is expected to cooperate with and follow the directions of the persons in charge of the activities and to act in a manner consistent with the spirit of good sportsmanship and to respect for the rights of others. 1. NOT FOR PROFIT: I further acknowledge and agree that the activities of the CGSC are community-based, volunteer, not-for-profit offerings that are not commercial or for profit in nature, despite the payment of costs or session fees paid on my child's behalf. 2. GOOD HEALTH: My child is in good health, and I know of no reason why he/she would be incapable of participation in the activities. My child knows how to swim. I will immediately notify the Coaches and the Director of CGSC if a change in my child's health or any other condition would affect my child's ability to participate. 3. WAIVER OF LIABILITY: On behalf of my child, myself, our heirs, distributes, guardians, legal representatives, successors and assigns, I waive and release any right that I, my child, my heirs, distributes, guardians, legal representatives, successors and assigns may have or acquire to make any claim against, sue, attach the property of, or prosecute CGSC, its officers, directors, members, employees, agents, coaches, volunteers, other CGSC participants, other CGSC participants parents and any affiliated organizations (all hereinafter referred to as "the Releasees") for monetary damages caused by injury to or death of my child or damage to the property of my child or myself arising from my child's participation in the Coconut Grove Windsurfing Sailing Program and any related activities, specifically including any injury, death or property damage resulting from the actions or omissions or negligence of CGSC, its officers, directors, members, employees, agents, coaches, and volunteers. (Parents and/or guardians shall initial here to indicate you have read this paragraph: **Initial:**_____)

4. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I am aware that the activities of Coconut Grove Sailing Club Windsurfing Program and related activities involve inherent risks including, but not limited to, maneuvering a boat, sailing aboard sailboats or other watercraft, including power boats, on deep waters in potentially hazardous conditions which may include,

among other things, cold water temperature, strong winds and high waves, storms, lightning, sudden and unexpected immersion in deep waters and collisions with other watercraft or stationary objects such as docks, pilings, and buoys as well as other dangers and risks inherent in occupying and operating a vessel on the bay and open seas. I am further aware that from time-to-time coaches or other responsible adults may need to transport my child in a private vehicle. With knowledge of the dangers involved, I voluntarily ask that my child be allowed to take part in all of these activities. **I ACCEPT ANY AND ALL RISKS TO MYSELF AND TO MY CHILD OF INJURY, DEATH AND PROPERTY DAMAGE ARISING FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES OF THE CGSC, COCONUT GROVE SAILING CLUB WINDSURFING PROGRAM OR ANY RELATED ACTIVITIES, SPECIFICALLY INCLUDING ANY INJURY, DEATH OR DAMAGE RESULTING FROM ANY ACTIONS OR OMISSIONS OR NEGLIGENCE BY BBYC, CGSC OR ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, MEMBERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, COACHES, AND VOLUNTEERS.** (Parents and/or guardians shall initial here to indicate you have read this paragraph: **Initial:**_____)

5. INDEMNITY AND HOLD HARMLESS: I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless BBYCYSP, its officers, directors, members, employees, agents, coaches and/or volunteers, specifically including for their own actions, omissions and negligence, from any and all claims for any injury, death to my child, or damage to my property, which may occur, as a result of my child's participation in the Coconut Grove Sailing Club Windsurfing Program or related activities. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless CGSC, its officers, directors, members, employees, agents, coaches and/or volunteers from any theft, loss, damage to or disappearance of any boat, equipment or personal property of myself or my child in any way involved in CGSC's activities. (Parents and/or guardians shall initial here to indicate you have read this paragraph: **Initial:**_____)

6. YOUTH SAILING SAFETY RULES AND CODE OF CONDUCT: CGSC safety rules and code of conduct have been created to facilitate and support the development of outstanding sailors; maintain the safety of all participants at all times; promote ethical behavior; and teach life-long lessons about character, teamwork, and respect for others.

- a) Follow all safety procedures and instructions given by Coaches and Directors and other responsible adults, including:
 - Life jackets must be worn and secured at all times on docks, piers, boats, or in the water by all students
 - Buffs/Gaiters must be worn at all times due to COVID-19 Restrictions
 - No swimming (except with the permission of the instructors)
 - No jumping off boats (except with the permission of the instructors)
 - No playing with boom, hoist or crane
 - Check for overhead wires in boat storage and launching areas
 - Club owned boats must be properly returned and put away after use
- b) Do not leave Coconut Grove Sailing Club or the site of an event without first obtaining personal permission from a coach, parent or event host. Sailors are personally responsible for obtaining prior consent from a responsible adult; it is not permissible to have another person convey a message that you are leaving.
- c) Attend as many practices as possible and show up and depart at the appointed times with all of your equipment. Make every effort to sail out and return to docks with Coaches or with a buddy. While sailing, students must stay within hailing distance of the safety/coach boat.
- d) Respect the property of the CGSC and others. Do not use another person's property without permission, steal or damage another person's property. Do not use hoists, sailboats or any equipment of the Club without the knowledge, permission or direction of the coaches.

- e) Sailors must make every effort to avoid collisions with other boats.
- f) Do not leave litter on the docks, club grounds or while on the water.
- g) Sailors are expected to act in a respectful way toward others at all times and set a good personal example for everyone supporting the principles of honesty, integrity and good sportsmanship.
- h) Treat other sailors, coaches, parents, and all others with respect. Do not engage in verbal, physical, or emotional abuse of anyone, and do not tolerate such conduct by others. No hitting, bullying, pushing, roughhousing, or inappropriately touch other sailors.
- i) Behave and dress at all times in a manner consistent with the high standards expected of youth sailors at Biscayne Bay Yacht Club. Never act in a way which would be embarrassing or detrimental to the Biscayne Bay Yacht Club.
- j) Do not use profane, insulting, harassing, humiliating or otherwise offensive language. Swearing is prohibited.
- k) The use of drugs or alcohol are strictly forbidden. Do not tolerate the use of alcohol, tobacco, or non-prescribed drugs by other sailors.

I agree that my child has read, understands and will abide by all CGSC safety rules and code of conduct and that failure to do may result in disciplinary action. Parents **Initial:** _____) Sailor's **Initial:** _____)

7. DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE: The Program safety rules, and code of conduct apply to all children and coaches involved in the CGSC Windsurfing Program. The CGSC discipline policy maintains that each sailor will have three chances to correct any violations.

- a) **First Offense:** The student will be warned verbally by the coach, who will report the incident to the Director who and student's file will be noted.
- b) **Second Offense:** Student will be verbally warned, and the parent/guardian will be informed and asked to meet with the Director and Coach.
- c) **Third Offense:** Any further abuse of these rules will result in a dismissal from the CGSC program. The Parent/guardian, Director and Club Manager will be informed.

I further agree that my child will abide by all CGSC safety rules and code of conduct and understand that any violation of these rules may result in disciplinary action being taken against my child, including potential dismissal from the program. Should my child be dismissed from the CGSC I shall remain liable for any unpaid fees, and no refund will be given for any fees pay to date. Coconut Grove Sailing Club **Windsurfing Program Safety Rules**

The following Coconut Grove Sailing Club (CGSC) rules are designed so our students can be safe on and off the water, have fun, and learn to windsurf safely and successfully in our program. This list represents our standard rules. Rules will be modified and additional rules will be made as necessary to ensure safety.

1. Coconut Grove Sailing Club is a private club. Non-Members are limited to drop-off and pick-up times, and may not remain on CGSC premises during program operating hours.
2. Listen and be respectful to your instructors at all times.
3. Lifejackets must be worn on the docks, while sailing, and in the coach boats.
4. Buffs/Gaiters must be worn on the docks, while sailing, and in the coach boats.
5. Only cast off with your instructor's permission.
6. Instructors are available to check your equipment before launching.
7. Pay attention and assist your classmates and other boaters (or alert your instructors) whenever help is needed.
8. Do not intentionally collide with other sailors. Always watch where you are steering so you can avoid collisions with classmates and other boaters.
9. When boating, be aware of the moving parts, (especially the boom, mast and lines) to avoid injury.
10. Pay close attention when learning to board, dock and disembark your equipment. Always follow proper procedures when boarding, docking and disembarking.
11. Protect your hands, legs, and body parts while docking and/or fending off.
12. No roughhousing- even with your friends.
13. Always recycle and throw away your trash. Be polite, don't pollute.
14. Please bring sunscreen. It must be applied before class and after lunch.
15. Do not bring valuables or electronics. CGSC is not responsible for lost or damaged items.
16. Plan to get wet. Always wear clothes you are not concerned about getting wet, including watches and jewelry. Bring a change of clothes and a towel every day.

Disciplinary Action

Safety is our primary concern. If a student breaks the rules, the instructor can implement disciplinary action. Our Instructors and Program Director will discuss the situation and apply the appropriate action to ensure the safety of the students and the program. Disciplinary action may include:

Verbal warning, Timeout, Chat with parents, Sitting out of an activity, Suspension from the program for the day, or Expulsion from the program (there are no financial rebates or refunds for suspension or expulsion).
